152) **LOCAL ISSUES TO BE DISCUSSED AND RESOLVED:**

General Village Improvements: **1)** Additional warning signs for cyclists and cars due to farming machinery vehicles coming onto the highway to be requested. **2)** Additional dog waste bin for SEGRO pathway, Church Street, Lockington. This may be funded by Segro, Councillor Nudd to confirm. **3)** The defibrillator for Hemington will be sited at the Jolly Sailor with an agreement with the owners.

Community Pavilion Project: Still applying for more funding and potential funding schemes.

Lockington Parking issues: To be resumed at a later date once lockdown is lifted.

St Modwen development update: Planning are still awaiting relevant documents and flood solutions for this development.

20/00718/FULM – Plot 12, EMG development. A lot of community support but unfortunately a majority of 6 for and 5 against on the planning committee the development will go ahead. Thanks, were given to District Councillor Carol Sewell for the effort she put in for objecting against it.

Mural for underpasses: Awaiting cost for the design work.

Playground re-opening: Both play areas will re-open Midday 10th August. On entering notices of how to follow the guidance given for Covid 19 prevention are to be adhered to. The Council thanked the residents for their understanding of the closures.

Environment Agency Flood Engagement: An on-going case file is currently being prepared, linked to the EMG development around non-weather-related discharges. The EA are now in contact with the SEGRO and a plan has

been agreed for modifications. The discoloration and water quality has been raised with them and work is to be carried out of vegetation spraying, removal of debris and silt. CCTV is arranged to the culverts, pipes and drains.

Village Hall: *The Parish Council is to have a meeting with the Village Hall Committee who are resigning as trustees to discuss the PC taking over as new trustees.*

Hire of play field: *A request has been made to hire the field for a wedding in 2022. The Council to advise that at present a decision cannot be made due to the uncertainty of the development.*

HGV issues: *With the support of local Councillors, District and County Councillor, MP together with Segro and Highways all onboard to hopefully find a solution to resolve the problem. New signage is required and SAT nav directions need to be addressed.*
